

Luke 23:33-43

³³ When they came to the place called the Skull, there they crucified him, along with the criminals — one on his right, the other on his left.

³⁴ **Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.**

³⁵ The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One."

³⁶ **The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar ³⁷ and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself."**

³⁸ There was a written notice above him, which read: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

³⁹ **One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"**

⁴⁰ But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? ⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong."

⁴² **Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."**

⁴³ Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise." ⁴⁴ It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour, ⁴⁵ for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two.

⁴⁶ **Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.**
