THE RELEVANCE OF THE REFORMATION — Part 2 of 5

In His incarnation as Jesus Christ He was conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He honored the divine law by His personal obedience, and in His substitutionary death on the cross... He made provision for the redemption of men from sin. He was raised from the dead with a glorified body and appeared to His disciples... He ascended into heaven and is now exalted at the right hand of God where He is the One Mediator, fully God, fully man, in whose Person is effected the reconciliation between God and man.
