Prayer Prompt: The Boko Haram entered Juliana's house. She watched as they dragged her husband out the door. "Do you renounce Christ?" they asked. "Will you follow us?" He remained silent. "Jesus" Juliana cried out. Then the Boko Haram fighters slapped her and shot her husband four times. She knelt and held him as he took his last breath. She buried his body, gathered her children and walked three days before reaching a camp for internally displaced people. She heard about a VOM supported training center that would help her. Boko Haram had killed her husband, made her a widow and left her children fatherless, but they couldn't make her deny Christ. Please pray for these brothers and sisters in Christ.
